When employees exit an organisation, assessing recent activity may limit loss and exposure. The Departed Employee Protocol details specific investigative tasks designed to identify potentially unethical activity.

Recent Activities

Our Examiners review recently deleted documents, recently printed documents, and a variety of other forms of evidence of the employee's behavior and activities immediately prior to departure. Additionally, we leverage our patented, concept-driven investigative platform, Riskcovery®, to assess an employee's communication trends to identify conversations and activities of potential concern.

Device Connections

When external media, such as hard drives, USB drives or even mobile phones are attached to a computer system, data exfiltration can occur. Our forensic Examiners assess whether - and when - external devices may have been connected as part of a departing employee's attempt to access and remove confidential information.

Internet Activity

We review the departed employee's recent internet activity, paying particular attention to any use of cloud-based services such as Dropbox™ and Google Drive - a common channel for data exfiltration.

Access

Our Examiners assess the departed employee's recent access to information assets, including file stores and networked devices, and assess the individual's activities relative to sensitive company information. 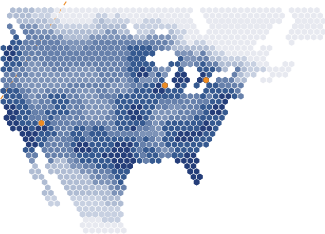

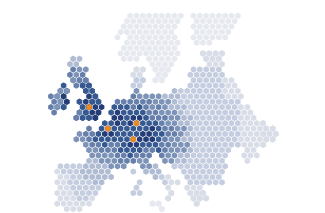

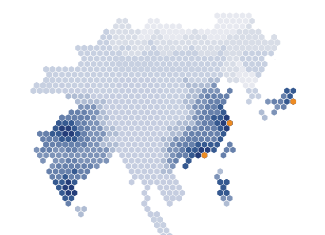

CASE STUDY:

Potential Loss Prevented

At the request of Counsel, Consilio's forensic Examiners conducted an assessment of a high-profile employee, using the Departed Employee Protocol. During the investigation, the Examiners analysed a forensic image of the employee's hard drive, a verifiable copy of the network share the employee used, and various logs and system files which record device connections, internet access, and the like.

Our investigation uncovered important information regarding the employee's activities prior to departure: 3 different USB drives had recently been connected to the company's secure computer system; there was also evidence that the employee had used both Dropbox™ and Google Drive.

Given this information, the client determined that the likelihood of data exfiltration by the target employee was high.

On the advice of Counsel, the client launched an expanded investigation into the employee's activities, uncovering additional evidence. Subsequently, the client notified the individual's new employer that the likelihood of data egress was high, and sent them a copy of the individual's non-compete/non-disclosure agreement, thereby proactively protecting company confidential information.
